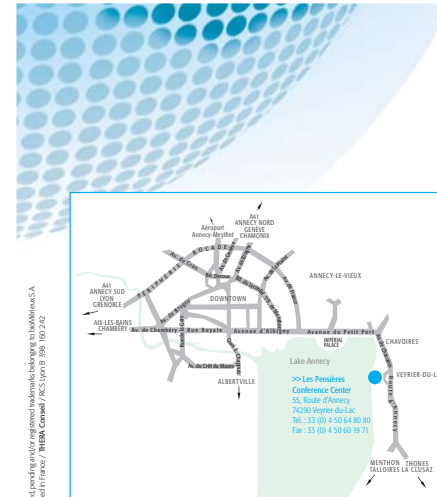

ACCESS

BY CAR

- Take the A41 Lyon-Grenoble highway and follow signs for Geneva
- Take exit 16 marked Anney Sud, Cran Gevrey, Seynod
- Take the Polsy expressway and head towards Lake Anney for 1.2 kilometers
- At Cran Gevrey, continue along the NS01 for 3.1 kilometers
- At Anney, follow signs for the lake and take Avenue de France till you reach the lakeside park (Parc de l'Impérial)
- Turn left at the Rue Est sign and follow signs for Veveyr, Monthon, Tallières
- At Avenue du Petit-Port, take the D909 along the lake and drive past Albigny to Chavoires
- Immediately after leaving Chavoires, at the entrance to Veveyr-du-Lac, take the service road on the right
- 200 meters down the hill, you will come to the Les Pensières car park, just before the Fondation Mérieux's main entrance.

BY PLANE

- Geneva Cointrin international airport (45 minutes away) is the best option
- Lyon Saint Exupéry international airport (1 hour away)
